### **Dry Set Porcelain Pavers for Outdoor Applications**

#### Course Description:

Porcelain Pavers are increasingly replacing stone for outdoor applications in Europe, and that trend continues in the United States. This course examines the long history to porcelain products, from ancient China, to medieval Europe, to modern America, and explains how the raw materials and manufacturing process create porcelain's legendary strength and durability. We review the testing procedures that scientifically verify porcelain's qualities, and discuss how technology helps create pavers that are superior in performance to stone or wood, stronger and with more reliable aesthetic. Finally, we explain the simple installation strategies for pavers used outdoors particularly on gravel or grass, which do not require a concrete slab. Throughout we offer case studies where the specifications of porcelain pavers solve unique design problems with style.
